N.S.SHEKHAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant family pension to the petitioner.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from Shri Navtej Pal Sing, Superintendent, submits that the case of the petitioner has been finalized by the respondents and the family pension as well as arrears of family pension shall be paid to the petitioner within a period of six weeks from today.

3. Learned State counsel further submits that the respondents shall also pay the interest @ 6% per annum on the arrears of family pension w.e.f. 19.08.2019, i.e. the date when the petitioner had submitted her affidavit with regard to making standard deductions from the family pension, till actual payment.

4. Mr. G.N. Malik, Advocate, is satisfied with the statement made by learned State counsel and in view of the same, does not press the petition.

5. Dismissed as not pressed.

6. Needless to observe that the respondents shall remain bound by the statement made by them before this Court today.
