1. The present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing award dated 16.10.2014 (Annexure P-8) passed by the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Bathinda (respondent No.1), whereby the petitioner (workman) had been declined the relief, as prayed for by him.
