- (i) The main case has been taken up today for hearing.
- (ii) The IOIN stands disposed of.

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1. Pursuant to the order dated 10.07.2025 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the report of the learned Mediator of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court has been received.
2. As per the report dated 28.07.2025 of the learned Mediator, the parties have settled their dispute by way of an amicable



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settlement/agreement, which is placed on the file.

3. As per the terms of the compromise, an enhanced amount of ₹4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) shall be payable by the payor, i.e., the insurance company, to the payee, i.e., the appellants, over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Jind, vide its Award dated 01.11.2013, within a period of 45 days from the date of signing of the present settlement, failing which interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on the enhanced amount.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the parties are also *ad idem* that the compromise has been arrived at with their free will and consent.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the appellants submits that the present appeal may be disposed of in terms of the compromise.

6. Disposed of accordingly.

7. Needless to say, the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement, and if any of the terms of the compromise is violated by any party, the other party shall be at liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings against him, whether for revival of the present appeal or for initiating any other proceedings, in accordance with law.

8. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
