1. Prayer in this petition is for proceeding against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for wilful disobedience of the order dated 25.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CRWP-4033-2025.

2. On an advance copy of petition having been served upon the respondent, he had put in appearance on 07.07.2025 through counsel, who informed the Court that in deference to the aforesaid order, representation dated 04.04.2025 stands disposed of by a speaking order. Time was sought for placing on record copy of the said order, verified by affidavit of the official concerned.

3. Today, on resumed hearing, compliance report by way of affidavit dated 21.07.2025 of Swapan Sharma, IPS, Commissioner of Police,



Ludhiana, has been filed. The same is taken on record. A copy of order dated 16.06.2025 purported to be passed in deference to order dated 25.04.2025 (supra) has been appended therewith as Annexure R-1. A copy of the compliance affidavit alongwith its annexure has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. In view of the aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the cause of action in the present petition does not survive and she seeks withdrawal of the petition with liberty to the petitioner for taking legal recourse against the order dated 16.06.2025 (Annexure R-1).

5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
