Through the instant writ petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a mandamus, upon the respondents No.1 to 3, to provide police protection to the petitioners and its employees, for the execution/performance of handling and transportation of trucks hired by the petitioners, at their respective Rice Mills, and other industrial units situated in Tehsil Rampura Phul, District Bathinda, from the hands of respondents No.4 and 5, and other members of Truck Union and Chhilka Labour Union of Rampura Phul, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the State, informs this Court that since the 'Standard Operating Procedure', has already been adopted by the State of Punjab, in order to ensure free movement of goods and freight, throughout the State of Punjab, therefore, the instant writ petition can be disposed of, in terms of order dated 15.01.2025, passed by this Court in CWP-20979-2023.
