1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the claim of the petitioner for regularisation in light of the policy decision dated 29.07.2011 from the date of regularisation of his juniors/similarly situated employees.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to the grievance, the petitioner(s) has already served a legal notice dated 01.05.2025 (Annexure P-4) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2-Director, Department of Ayurvedic, Haryana is directed to consider and decide the above said legal notice, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. He, however, does not have any objection to the above request.



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5. Accordingly, the present petition is **disposed of** with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.2-Director, Department of Ayurvedic, Haryana to consider and decide the legal notice dated 01.05.2025 (Annexure P-4) served by the petitioner by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of **four** months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.
