After arguing the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition at this stage. However, has requested that keeping in view the custody of the petitioner, the learned trial Court may be asked to expedite the trial.

In view of the statement, petition stands dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

However, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since long and only 02 witnesses have been examined out of 13 witnesses cited by the prosecution, the learned trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments and to make earnest efforts to conclude the trial expeditiously.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, is also directed to ensure the presence of the witnesses before the learned trial Court, in

pursuance to the summons so issued by it, by deputing a responsible Gazetted Officer for this purpose.
