The prayer in this petition under Section 482 of the BNSS is for grant of anticipatory bail to the appellant in case bearing rapat no.31 dated 04.12.2020 under Sections 307, 323, 382, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act in FIR No.336 dated 29.11.2020 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at P.S. Kathu Nangal, Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.08.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 10.09.2025 by way of an affidavit of Dharminder Kalyan, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Majitha, Amritsar (Rural) has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on

instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 18.08.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands disposed of.
