Status report by way of affidavit of Karan Singh Sandhu, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kharar-1, District S.A.S. Nagar, filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, is taken on record.

In the status report, it has been alleged that daughter of the petitioner, namely, Komal eloped with Gursewak Singh (respondent No.4) and later on she got married to respondent No.4 on 09.06.2025 at Jalandhar. She is a major and is 20 years old. She got married to respondent No.4- Gursewak Singh with her own sweet will and they are residing together. Daughter of petitioner, namely, Komal and respondent No.4-Gursewak Singh also got their statements recorded on 19.07.2025, wherein they stated that they have married with their own sweet will and they are residing together. They further stated that they do not require any police protection.

It has been submitted that in view of the above stated facts and circumstances, daughter of the petitioner is not in illegal custody of respondent No.4 and rather she has got married with respondent No.4 as per her own free will and both of them were residing together.

In view of the status report submitted by learned State counsel, no further order is required to be passed and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

As such, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
