1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, is for setting aside of order dated 15.05.2025 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Sessions Judge, Moga, whereby non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued against the petitioner in case FIR No.197, dated 23.12.2021, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to appear and surrender before the Trial Court, however, he be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court and directions be given to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S.Deol, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with the following directions:-

The petitioner is to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner. This is contingent upon the petitioner paying a cost of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with the concerned District Legal Services Authority.

6. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail, the Trial Court shall make earnest efforts to decide the same expeditiously, in accordance with law.
