HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 26.05.2025 (Annexure P-15) passed by learned Deputy Commissioner, Mahendergarh at Narnaul, Haryana and also order dated 20.06.2025 (Annexure P-19) by learned Commissioner, Gurugram, Division Gurugram.

2. Learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner was suspended from the post of Sarpanch vide order dated 26.05.2025 and almost six months have elapsed since then. It is further submitted that regular inquiry into the allegations on which the petitioner has been suspended is still pending consideration before the Competent Authority. Learned Senior counsel contends that petitioner would be satisfied at this stage if appropriate directions are issued for completion of regular inquiry pending against the petitioner in a time bound manner.



3. At this stage Mr. Rajiv Malhotra, DAG, Haryana appears on behalf of State does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has been suspended for the last almost six months and even the regular inquiry is still pending. He further submits that in all probabilities the regular inquiry pending against the petitioner would be completed expeditiously, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and all concerned parties by way of passing a speaking order.

4. Keeping in view the stand taken by all the respective parties, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Deputy Commissioner, Mahendergarh at Narnaul to conclude the regular inquiry pending against the petitioner expeditiously, preferably by 15.12.2025.

5. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
