This is a petition under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, for appointment of an independent Arbitrator to adjudicate the disputes and differences which have arisen between the parties out of Letter of Acceptance-cum-Work Order, dated 09.03.2021, Annexure P-1, whereby the petitioner was awarded tender on account of engagement of freight forwarder for export of consignment from Mumbai Sea Port to the Beira/Maputo Sea Port, Mozambique.

2. Learned counsel representing the respondent contends that the respondent has no objection to the prayer made.

3. Accordingly, petition is allowed. Mr. Justice (Retd.) Rameshwar Singh Malik, formerly a Judge of this Court, resident of B-13, Mayfair Gardens, Hauz Khas, August Kranti Marg, New Delhi, Mobile No.7837049206, is nominated as Arbitrator to adjudicate the disputes between the parties, subject to compliance of statutory provisions.
