The petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023, seeking a direction to the official respondents to transfer the investigation of case FIR No.0224 dated 16.10.2024, registered under Sections 221, 109, 132, 191(3), 190, 303(1) BNSS, 2023, Sections 132 and 134 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, at Police Station Patran, District Patiala, to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI).

2. Learned State counsel contends that after completion of investigation, challan/final report in the case has already been filed on 24.07.2025. It is also contended that the petitioner has been nominated as an accused in the case, and is therefore not entitled to seek transfer of investigation as already held by this Court in CRWP No.550 of 2025 titled *Roop Singh and others v. State of Punjab and others*, vide order dated 08.07.2025.



- 3. In view of the settled law that an accused person has no right to seek transfer of investigation, the petition cannot be entertained and stands dismissed.
- 4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
