ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he is confining the prayer in this petition to the expeditious disposal of the appeal (Annexure P-2) preferred by petitioner No.1, which is pending adjudication before the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal, New Delhi.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 has challenged the order of the Debts Recovery Tribunal-II, Chandigarh, by preferring an appeal before the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal, New Delhi. He submits that the matter had been partly heard on 04.06.2025 and thereafter the matter could not be taken up for hearing. He submits that the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal, New Delhi, be directed to decide the above said appeal in a time bound manner.
