Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for regularization in Board's service keeping in view the instructions issued by the State of Punjab and duly adopted by the respondent-Board.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to their grievances, the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 21.01.2025 (Annexure P-6) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioners would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.1- The Chairman, BBMB, Sector 19-B, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 21.01.2025 (Annexure P-6) served by the petitioners, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Karan Nehra, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. He, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 21.01.2025 (Annexure P-6) by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.
