Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari to set aside order dated 22.05.2025 (Annexure P-8) passed by the learned Divisional Deputy Director, Rural Development and Panchayat, Patiala (respondent No.2), whereby the *raqba* of Gram Panchayat, Akalgarh (petitioner) has been divided and given to Gram Panchayat, Navi Abadi Akalgarh (respondent No.5).

2. Mr. Nirmaljit Singh Diwana, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab appears on behalf of the respondent-State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to him, and submits that the order impugned in the instant writ petition would be

revisable under Section 201 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the aforesaid submission made by learned State counsel, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail its remedy of revision under Section 201 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 against the impugned order dated 22.05.2025 (Annexure P-8).

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
