HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.3-Jitender Singh was suspended on 01.07.2025 keeping in view the registration of FIR against him but immediately, on the very next day, an order dated 02.07.2025 (Annexure P-7) was passed by the appellate authority staying the order of suspension. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that more than one month elapsed but the appeal has not been heard, which is further causing prejudice to the petitioner.

2. Learned State counsel submits that the appeal preferred by respondent No.3-Jitender Singh will be decided within a period of two weeks from today.

3. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the



present writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent concerned to decide the appeal within two weeks from today and pass a speaking order.

3. As the petitioner is the complainant, on whose complaint the FIR was registered against respondent No.3-Jitender Singh, which was the basis of his suspension, the petitioner be also heard before passing the speaking order on the appeal.
