SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of appropriate writ, with the following substantive prayer:

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that this petition may kindly be accepted and appropriate direction may kindly be issued to the respondents No.2 and 7 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of respondents No. 8 to 12 as enshrined under Article 21 of the Constitution of India as the respondents no. 8 to 12 are openly threatening the petitioners & their family members to eliminate them and are trying to involve them in some false criminal case out of whom respondent no. 8 is a police official.

It is further prayed that an appropriate direction may also be issued to the official respondents to take appropriate action against the private respondents who are causing immense threats to the petitioners and their family members.

It is further prayed that an appropriate direction may kindly be issued to the official respondents not to act hand in gloves with the private respondents no. 8-12 and not to submit the petitioners in the hands of the private respondents.

It is further prayed that an appropriate direction to the official respondents to decide the representations dated 28.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) & 28.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner no. 1, in the interest of justice.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer and submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, for the *nonce*, if a direction is



issued to respondent No.3 to consider and take a conscious decision on the representations (Annexure P-1 and P-2) made by the petitioners in a time bound manner.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. On the strength of the advance notice, Mr. Jatinder Pal Singh, Senior DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. He submits he has no objection in case the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, is accepted.
- 5. I have heard learned counsel for the rival parties and have perused the paper-book with their assistance.
- 6. Keeping in view the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case & without going into merits thereof, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar (respondent No.3 herein) to look into the representations (Annexures P-1 and P-2) moved by the petitioners; objectively consider the grievance(s) raised in the said representations & take ratiocinated decision thereupon after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks from today. Such decision be communicated to the petitioners within fifteen days of it being taken.
- 7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
