JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.(ORAL)

The prayer in the petition under Section 482 C r.PC is for directing the respondent no.2 to take immediate action on the representation dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) for transfer of Investigation of FIR No.52 dated 02.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Section 406, 420 IPC registered at P.S. City Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar to some other district and conducting a fair enquiry.

2. The Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is an aggrieved person/victim but has been made out to be an accused in the aforementioned FIR. DSP Iqbal Singh who is investigating the matter is inimical to her and has been threatening her to compromise the matter with the private respondents.

3. The Counsel for the State and the private respondent on the



other hand have vehemently opposed the prayer made and contend that the petitioner has no right to seek transfer of investigation.

4. I have heard counsel for the parties.
5. Without going into the rival contentions of either sides but in order to ensure fair investigation into the aforesaid FIR, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Director General of Police, Punjab to constitute an SIT of police officials other than those from SBS Nagar to investigate the matter and submit a final report to the jurisdictional court pursuant to the said investigation within one month from the date of receipt of the certified coy of the order.
