1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to release the family pension and other dues to the petitioner under the Old Pension Scheme/Rules on account of death of her husband on 19.11.2021.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to the grievance, the petitioner(s) has already served a legal notice dated 22.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2-Director General, Department of Panchayat and Development, Haryana is directed to consider and decide the above said legal notice, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file



response, if necessary. He, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is **disposed of** with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.2-Director General, Department of Panchayat and Development, Haryana to consider and decide the legal notice dated 22.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of **four** months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.
