1. In the present petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release all the retiral benefits of the petitioner, which have been withheld by the respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide representation dated 12.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) served by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Vikas Arora, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 and 2; whereas Mr. Sanjeev



Soni, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4. They do not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 12.05.2025 (Annexure P-2), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law. In event, the petitioner is held entitled for grant of relief as per the law as claimed in the representation dated 12.05.2025 (Annexure P-2), the same be also released within a period of 02 months thereafter.
