Prayer made in present writ petition is for directing the respondents to grant family pension in respect of the service of Late Sh. Deep Chand son of Lal Chand to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.10.2021 along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2 After arguing the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that with regard to the grievance, the petitioner(s) has/have already submitted a representation dated 11.12.2024 (Annexure P-

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8) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner(s) would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.1 is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 11.12.2024 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioner(s), by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

3 Notice of motion.

4 Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. He, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

5 Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation dated 11.12.2024 (Annexure P-8) by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

6 Needless to mention that if upon considering the said representation, in case any monetary benefit is found due and payable to the petitioner(s), the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner(s) within a further period of three months.
