The petition has been filed seeking a direction to respondents no.1 and 2 to protect the petitioner's life and liberty from official respondents no.3 to 14 and private respondents no.15 to 25.

2. Learned State counsel contended that with the same grievance the petitioner approached this Court earlier by filing a petition, CRWP-2709-2025, which was disposed of, vide order dated 16.05.2025, with the following observations:

2. Learned State counsel has referred to the status report, dated 09.05.2025, filed by respondent no.2 and contends that there is no threat to the petitioner's life and liberty as on date. He also contends that instructions have been issued to provide the area security through regular patrolling at the petitioner's residence; besides, new arms licence has been recommended for the



petitioner as well as his brother. The relevant paragraphs of the status report to this effect are as follows:

13. That the DIG, Patiala Range, Patiala has further reported that a detailed threat analysis and risk assessment was conducted as per protocol for private protectees. It has been found that petitioner Satvir Chand is a Government Teacher residing at Village Nawa Gaon, PS Khanauri, District Sangrur. The DIG, Patiala Range, Patiala has further reported that as per Threat Perception Report, there is no threat to the petitioner at his village Nawa Gaon PS Khanauri, District Sangrur.

Satvir Chand has alleged that he was attacked at the instance of MLA Shutrana (Patiala). Further it has been alleged that Satvir Chand was transferred from Village Chicharwala to Government Primary School Ratta District Gurdaspur at the instance of MLA Shutrana. The threat analysis and risk assessment report of the petitioner reveals that the petitioner feels victimized as he was transferred from Government Primary School, village Chicharwala District Patiala to Government Primary School, Ratta District Gurdaspur.

14. That it has been further reported that Satvir Chand as well as his brother Jasvir Chand has applied for a new Arms License, which is under process with the office of Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur. The office of SSP, Sangrur has recommended the case for issuance of new Arms License to the petitioner Satvir Chand and his brother Jasvir Chand.

15. That it has been reported that based on the facts and circumstances of the case, area security through regular patrolling has been constantly provided to Satvir Chand at his residence at village Nawa Gaon Police Station Khanauri District Sangrur. Further contact details of local police station as well as police control room as well as mobile phone numbers of Dy. SP Sub-Division, Patran, SHO PS



Patran and SHO PS Shutrana have been provided to Satvir Chand for obtaining swift help in case of any emergency. Furthermore, Satvir Chand has been apprised about his rights under the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for protection issued by the State Government. He has been advised to install CCTV cameras around his residence. The police have taken requisite action as per protocol and State Security Policy. As stated above there is no threat to the petitioner at his village Nawa Gaon PS Khanauri, District Sangrur. He has now been transferred to Government Primary School, Ratta District Gurdaspur which has lowered the threat perception to the petitioner Satvir Chand.

3. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of.

4. Ordered accordingly.

3. Regarding the incident alleged by the petitioner an FIR no.20 dated 04.02.2025, under Sections 117(1), 115(2), 351(3) and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023, has already been lodged, and investigation by a Special Investigation Team (SIT) is in progress. As per the status report dated 01.09.2025, filed by fourth respondent, the threats alleged to have been faced by the petitioner were also examined by the SIT, which reached the following conclusion:

18. That accordingly, the Special Investigation Team after a detailed and thorough investigation has observed that at present there is no threat or danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner as there is no involvement of any person found in the alleged incident at whose hands the petitioner is apprehending danger. The SIT has submitted its report vide No.1315/A/SP/City dated 16.04.2025 with the office of SSP Patiala with above observations and also with the recommendation that since the petitioner resides in the jurisdictional police of District Sangrur, hence a letter be



issued to Id. SSP Sangrur for taking necessary steps for the safety/protection of the petitioner.

4. These conclusions could not be disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner on the basis of any document or material on record.
5. In view thereof, the petition stands disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to approach Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, in case he faces any threat to his life and liberty in future who will take appropriate action in the matter, in accordance with law.
6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
