Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No. 1 to decide the revision petition (ROR-1160-2022), titled as '*Baljit Singh and others Versus AC 1st Grade and others*', expeditiously in a time bound manner.
