1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 483 BNSS with a prayer to grant regular bail to him in case FIR No.69 dated 02.11.2024, registered under Sections 117(2), 191(3), 190 BNS, 2023 (later on added Sections 109, 238 of BNS, 2023), Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

2. The FIR in the present case was registered on the basis of the statement made by Paramjit Kaur wife of Gurdev Singh and the same has been reproduced below:-

“Statement of Paramjit Kaur wife of Gurdev Singh, resident of Village Raipur Peeru Bakhash, Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala aged about 48 years mobile No.82041 39855 stated that I am the resident of above mentioned address and I am doing



household work. That on 27.10.2024 I was driving active PB 57C 1275 white colour and my maid namely Harpreet Kaur alias Happy who was carrying my granddaughter Gursift Kaur and was sitting on pillion on my activa. We were going to Jhangi Gurudwara Sahib, Village Maqsoodpur and then one CD Deluxe motorcycle was coming behind us and two unknown persons were present on the above vehicle whose faces were muffled and another motorcycle mark Splendor was following them and three unknown persons were present on the splendor motorcycle, however the face of the person who was driving the motorcycle was not muffled who is recognized by me as Gurdit Singh alias Deep son of Charan Singh, resident of Colony Bholath near Beyi Pool and the unknown persons sitting as pillion rider on CD Deluxe attacked with Datar and hit at my head due to which I received grievous injury in my head and blood started oozing out of my head, I was frightened and therefore, stopped my scooty on one side of the road. My maid Harpreet Kaur was carrying my granddaughter Gursift Kaur and she was looking for help from random people present there. Meanwhile one person who was coming on the activa stopped his activa and took me to the local clinic in the village for firstaid whereby I was given treatment by the doctor however, as the flow of the blood was not stopping therefore, I called my daughter in law Simarajit Kaur who came in the car and took me to the civil hospital Bholath for further treatment whereby after seeing the blood, the doctor did not admit me there and therefore, my daughter in law got me admitted in sacred Heart Hospital, Maqsuda, District Jalandhar whereby I am under treatment. Gurdit Singh alias Deep son of Charan Singh, resident of Colony Bholath near Beyi Pul Bholath who was earlier also used to quarrel with us and threat us to face dire consequences, we have tried to stop him from harassing us many times but he did not mend his ways. The reason of enmity is that Gurdit Singh alias Deep have attacked on me in connivance with his four unknown



persons. Therefore, kindly take strict legal action against above Gurdit Singh alias Deep and his persons who have helped him in attacking me. Statement recorded and admitted to be true and correct. Sd/-Paramjit Kaur.”

3. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not initially named in the FIR and has been nominated as an accused on the basis of the disclosure statement suffered by co-accused. Even as per the said statement, the petitioner was the driver of one of the motorcycle and the injury was caused by Charan Singh, who was a pillion rider. He further contends that the parties have compromised the matter with each other and the main accused namely Gurdit Singh @ Deep has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by a coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 12.05.2025 (Annexure P-4).

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner and he does not deserve the concession of bail by this Court.

5. Mr. Anuj Tanwar, Advocate for the complainant submits that he has no objection in case the petition is allowed by this Court. He has also filed his power of attorney on behalf of the complainant, which is taken on record.

6. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

7. In the present case, the petitioner is stated to be in custody for the last more than 04 months and challan has been presented against him. The parties have entered into a compromise in the present case and still further main



accused namely Gurdit Singh @ Deep has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 12.05.2025 (Annexure P-4).

Thus, the further custody of the petitioner will not serve any useful purpose.

8. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
