1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the letter dated 16.09.2022 (Annexure P-4) vide which the respondent no. 2 wrongly deducted the amount of medical reimbursement bills. Further, a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to reimburse the deducted amount of medical bills of the petitioner's wife as she was suffering from Cancer and in case of chronic disease deduction could not be made in view of instructions dated 28.05.2003 (Annexure P-7). Further, case of the petitioner is covered by Judgment passed by the *Hon'ble Supreme Court in case titled "Secretary to the Government of Haryana versus Vidya Sagar" reported as 2010 AIR (Supreme Court) 196 (Annexure P-8)*.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner is covered by the judgment of Supreme Court dated 16.07.2009 passed in *"Secretary to the Government of Haryana versus Vidya Sagar"* reported as *2010 AIR (Supreme Court) 196 (Annexure P-8)* as well as the judgment passed by this Court in *CWP-6027-2016 dated 12.09.2023 (Annexure P-9) titled as "Bhagat Ram vs. State of Haryana and Others"*.

3. Learned State counsel undertakes before this Court the representation submitted by the petitioner will be decided afresh qua the balance of medical reimbursement in the light of judgment dated 16.07.2009 and 12.09.2023 (Annexures P-8 & P-9) within a period of six weeks by passing a speaking order and a copy of such order will be provided to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

4. In the light of above, the present petition stands disposed off.
