JASBIR SINGH VS. ANIL KUMAR AND OTHERS

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.14,00,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakh only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant-Jasbir Singh.

However, as per statement of learned counsel for the respondent-insurance Company, it is made clear that so far as amount of Rs.14,00,000/- enhanced compensation and the amount awarded by learned MACT is concerned, the recovery rights already given by the MACT to Insurance Company will remain intact as the owner/driver was proceeded ex-parte before the MACT. They had not filed any cross-appeal against the finding of the learned MACT. In this appeal, recovery rights have also not been contested by them.

We dispose of this case with a direction to Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.14,00,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakh only) in the name of the appellant-Jasbir Singh with a recovery rights to recover the same from respondents No.1 and 2 with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 03.03.2025 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
