The present writ petition has been filed seeking directions to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for regularization of their services under regularization policy dated 01.10.2003, 10.02.2004 and 13.08.2004 as amended up to date along with all consequential benefits and arrears.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 03.02.2025 (Annexure P-4) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.3-the Divisional Forest Officer,

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Rewari is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 03.02.2025 (Annexure P-4) served by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vivek Chauhan, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. He, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 03.02.2025 (Annexure P-4) by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.
