Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the respondent-State not to take any arbitrary or coercive action against the petitioner or his family members by repeatedly calling them in Police Station.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has availed loan from Kotak Mahindra Bank i.e. respondent No.4. It is submitted that the dispute is totally of civil nature, but the respondent-bank has initiated police action, which is not even maintainable. He submits that the Police is unnecessarily harassing the petitioner.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate complaint/representation before respondent No.3 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar within a period of one week from today and thereafter, the necessary action would be taken in the same, in accordance with law.
