The writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to remove the anomaly and enhance the age of retirement of the petitioner from 57 to 60 years at par with the case of other senior ranks in the Force.



Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the respondents have moved CM-7183-CWP-2021 for disposing of the petition as having been rendered infructuous in view of the instructions (Annexure R-5) bearing No. P.III-01/2021-NWS-EC-1 dated 23.03.2021. He further contends that the petitioner has already been given all the benefits except Non-Functional Selection Grade/HAG. He thus contends that since the substantive benefits have already been released, the present writ petition may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous and liberty be granted to the petitioner to pursue his claim for Non-Functional Selection Grade/HAG with the respondent-authorities.

Mr. Lalit Kumar Gupta, Advocate enters appearance and files memorandum of appearance on behalf of respondent-UIO today in the Court and the same is taken on record. He submits that he has no objection to the same.

The present writ petition as well as CM-7183-CWP-2021 are disposed of accordingly as having rendered infructuous with the liberty as aforesaid.

All pending civil misc. application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
