1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No. 2 (Deputy Commissioner, Patiala) not to dispossess the petitioners by using police force from the land owned and possessed by them.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for petitioners prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to the petitioners to raise all pleas, as raised in this petition, by filing an appropriate application before the civil court, where civil suit (Annexure P-10), filed by the petitioners, is stated to be pending.
