The prayer in the present petition under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 is for issuance of directions to the respondents to refrain from conducting multiple inquiries against the petitioner and his aides on the basis of frivolous/ repeated complaints in FIR No.181 dated 21.08.2024 registered under Sections 329(3), 62, 303(3), 351(2), 191(3), 190 BNS, 2023 at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case where the petitioner himself has levelled allegations against certain persons because of which an FIR No.181 dated 21.08.2024 under Sections 329(3), 62, 303(3), 351(2), 191(3), 190 BNS, 2023 Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana came to be registered against those persons. As a counter-blast one of the said persons namely Kamaljit Singh is filing multiple complaints against the petitioner. It is his contention that on the same cause of action multiple

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inquiries were initiated against the petitioner and he has been found to be innocent.

The present petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent Nos.2, 3 and 4 to proceed in accordance with law but only after duly examining the inquiry reports exculpating the petitioner.
