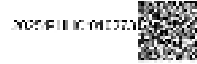

Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS seeking issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 for taking immediate appropriate action against respondent No. 3.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report dated 22.01.2025 in the Court today, which is taken on record and he, at the very outset submits that nothing survives in the present petition. In fact, respondent No. 4 made a complaint which was inquired into by respondent No. 3 and during the course of inquiry of said complaint, respondent No. 3 issued a *Parwana* (Annexure P-1) to the petitioner and others for joining in the inquiry.

Thereafter, petitioner also moved a representation dated 30.07.2024 and submitted that she has no concern with the dispute and her representation was also marked to respondent No. 3 and after obtaining opinion from the District Attorney, FIR No. 91 dated 27.08.2024 under Section 498-A of Indian Penal Code has been registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hosiarpur against Sukhjinder Singh son of Jagjeet Singh



and the accused in the aforementioned FIR is brother of the petitioner and he further refers to para No. 9 of the status report and submits that petitioner was not harassed by respondent No. 3 as alleged by her and further the inquiry has already culminated into registration of the FIR.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Thus, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
