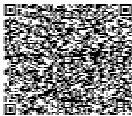

SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. This order shall dispose of these three petitions, filed by Gulshan,
Sawan @ Judi and Deepak @ Deepu, for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 105



dated 17.08.2022 under Sections 302, 323, 427, 212, 201, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

2. Learned counsel for the State of Punjab has filed custody certificates of petitioners Gulshan and Deepak @ Deepu, which are taken on record.

3. Petitioners Gulshan, Sawan @ Judi and Deepak @ Deepu, who are alleged with murder, have been in custody since 22.11.2022, 01.02.2023 and 16.02.2024, respectively.

3.1 It is not disputed at the Bar by learned counsel for the rival parties that there are four eye witnesses in the case, and one of them, namely Satnam Singh @ Nikku is yet to be examined by the prosecution.

3.2 Looking to the gravity of offence and to ensure safe and secure atmosphere for the principal witnesses to depose before trial court, this Court, for the time being, declines bail to the petitioners.

4. Accordingly, these petitions stand dismissed for the time being, with liberty to petitioners to re-visit the Court, in case the trial gets further delayed or after the main prosecution witnesses are examined, whichever is earlier.
