The petitioner has filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner and to provide him suitable job, as per his qualification.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-5) to the respondent-authorities and at this stage, he shall be satisfied in case, appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Swapan Shorey, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and has no serious objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record

carefully.

At this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking and well reasoned order.
