KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant writ petition, as cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made for issuance of a Mandamus upon respondents No.1 and 2, to look into the complaint/representation (Annexure P-9), as submitted by the petitioner, and take a suitable action.

2. On 08.07.2025, learned counsel, appearing for respondents No.1 and 2, had caused appearance and sought time to apprise this Court about the exact status of the complaint/representation (supra).

3. Today, learned counsel for respondents No.1 and 2, has supplied a copy of the Inquiry Report dated 28.04.2025, as prepared by the Internal Complaints Committee, constituted by the competent authority of the University concerned, and the same is taken on record as 'Mark A'.



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4. Learned counsel for the petitioner makes all endeavour to impresses upon this Court that the Inquiry Report (supra), is nothing, but an eye-wash, as the main allegation has yet not been dealt with by the Committee concerned. However, he, after having apt instructions from the quarter concerned, submits that, as the petitioner intends to throw a challenge to the Inquiry Report (supra), she be granted liberty to do so.

5. The asked for request is accepted.

6. Accordingly, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**, with liberty to the petitioner to lay challenge to the Inquiry Report (supra), by filing apt motion, under the apt provisions of law.
