This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents not to harass the petitioners.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that a speaking order has already been passed in the representation dated 03.07.2025 (Annexure P-5) by the authorities concerned and has produced the copy of the same, which is taken on record. He has furnished a copy of the order to counsel for the petitioners. The same is reproduced hereinbelow :-

*‘I request you that there is no application given by
petitioner Neelam Rani daughter of Balwant Singh, wife of Sunil
and son of Sukhdev Singh, resident of Dera Sacha Sauda*

Colony, Fazilka, Gali Hussain regarding safety of herself and her belongings.

Petitioner Neelam Rani, daughter of Balwant Singh, wife of Sunil and son of Sukhdev Singh, resident of Dera Sacha Sauda Colony, Fazilka, Gali Hussain registered a writ petition in respectable Punjab and Haryana High Court Chandigarh, an intimation regarding this petition is received yesterday in Police Station. Till now the above writ petitioner Neelam Rani etc does not intimated or contacted and does not give her written statement in the local police station regarding safety of herself and her belongings.

If in future, petitioner Neelam Rani etc has come to police station to demand safety of herself and her belongings, then safety will be provided according to Law. Petitioner has given her address as Neelam Rani daughter of Balwant Singh, wife of Sunil and son of Sukhdev Singh, resident of Dera Sacha Sauda Colony, Fazilka, Gali Hussain in her writ petition.'

In light of the above, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press this petition further.

The petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure, in the light of notification No.HOMEHM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch), in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.

Petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
