The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 528 of The Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanita 2023 (BNSS), praying for issuance of directions to respondent no. 1 to 5 to conduct fair and impartial investigation of case FIR No. 66 dated 18.06.2025 registered under Section 115(2), 351(2), 351(3), 190, 191(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanita (BNS), 2023 at Police Station Bhadson, District Patiala got registered by the petitioner No.1 and to ensure that the petitioners may not be harassed to effect compromise with the accused of above FIR i.e. respondent no.6 to 8 and respondent no.9 who has not been arrayed as accused in the above FIR in the interest of justice, equity and fair play.

Reply filed by way of an affidvit of Mandeep Kaur, PPS. Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Nabha, District Patiala, is taken on record.

The relevant paras of said affidavit reads as under:-

“That after thorough inquiry, FIR was registered, on. 18.06.2025 U/S 115 (2), 351 (2), 351 (3), 190 and 191 (3) at Police Station Bhadson, District Patiala against Gurpreet Singh. Joga Singh Nirmal Singh and 2-3 unknown persons.

That after registration of the case, the investigation was being carried out by ASI Amrik Singh, who recorded the statement of witnesses and went to the spot and inspected the spot in the presence of Daljit Kaur d/o Major Singh resident of Village Bhirhano.

That on 22.06.2025, ASI Amrik Singh moved an application to Senior 'Medical Officer, PGI Chandigarh through HC Shafi Mohammad, to supply the bed head ticket and medical record of injured Gurpal Singh and that application was received by Medical Record Department on 23.06.2025 and they advised the Investigating Officer to collect the medical record after about 1 month. HC Shafi Mohammad made a DDR entry in Police Post Dandrala Dhindsa, to this effect.

In view of the above as well as the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner that investigation is undergoing, nothing survives in the instnat petition.

Hence, the same is disposed off, having been rendered infructuous.

Pending application(s), if any shall disposed off, accordingly.
