1. The instant petition under Section 482 BNSS has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.133 dated 11.05.2025, under Sections 125, 351(3), 324(4) (109, 191(3) and 190 added later on) BNS and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Phase-1, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, S.A.S. Nagar, vide order dated 11.07.2025, while exercising powers under Section 480(5) of the BNSS, has directed the arrest of the petitioner, despite the fact that he was already released on bail by a detailed order dated 14.05.2025 in respect of all the offences, except under Section 109 of the BNS.
3. In view of the above, petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to file a fresh and exhaustive one, by challenging the impugned order(s).
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty sought and recorded



hereabove.

5. However, to enable the petitioner to carry out the necessary exercise, the operation of the order dated 11.07.2025, passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, S.A.S. Nagar, a copy of which has been submitted in Court today by the petitioner’s counsel, shall remain stayed until 18.07.2025.
