1. This petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, alleging wilful disobedience of order dated 07.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CRM-M-20951-2025.
2. Mr. Puru Jarewal, DAG, Punjab, is present in Court on having been served an advance copy of the petition and puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent. He submits that in deference to the order dated 07.05.2025, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), vide order dated 05.07.2025, has disposed of the representation dated 24.03.2025 made by the petitioner. A copy whereof has been produced in Court and also furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, after going through the said order dated 05.07.2025, submits that the cause of action does not survive in



the present petition and the same be disposed of as such by granting liberty to the petitioner to take judicial recourse against the order dated 05.07.2025, in accordance with law, if so advised.

4. The present petition is disposed of with liberty aforesaid.
