The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.39 dated 05.12.2023 registered under Sections 420, 218, 120-B, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 13 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at P.S. ACB, Gurugram, District Anti Corruption Bureau, Haryana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 08.07.2025 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Raj Kiran submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated



08.07.2025 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 08.07.2025 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
