1. Through this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondent No.2 – The National Highways Authority of India (for short – NHAI) not to take possession of and demolish the pillar in the front portion of the petitioner's house.

2. At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-NHAI submits that he has express instructions to say that while taking possession of the acquired land which is part of and also abuts the petitioner's house, the pillar in the front portion of the petitioner's house, which also supports the petitioner's first floor, shall not be taken possession of or demolished.

3. The afore statement made by learned counsel for the respondent – NHAI satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.
