Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 17.03.2025 passed in CWP No. 7168 of 2025 (Annexure P-1), certain benefits have been granted and the State has also preferred a Letters Patent Appeal against order dated 17.03.2025. He submits that since substantial benefits have been granted, he does not press the contempt petition at this stage and that in case something remains to be granted after the LPA is finally decided, the petitioner shall avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law.
