Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari to set aside order dated 30.06.2023 (Annexure P-8) passed by the learned Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Khadoor Sahib and order dated 01.08.2023 (Annexure P-11) passed by the learned District Development and Panchayat Officer, Tarn Taran, whereby respondent No.6 was appointed as Administrator of Gram Panchayat, Khojkipur.

1.1 A further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.3 (District Development and Panchayat Officer, Tarn Taran) to decide representation dated 23.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner.

2. Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
3. Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that the instant writ petition has become infructuous as the term of Panchayat already stands expired.
4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, the present writ petition is accordingly disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, in case any of the grievances of petitioner still remains unaddressed, she shall be at liberty to seek revival of this writ petition.
6. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
