This is a petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, (BNSS), 2023 seeking directions to respondent No.1 to keep any proposal for arresting the petitioners in any FIR instituted on the basis of complaint made by respondent No.2 in abeyance for a specific period of time so as to enable them to seek recourse to their legal remedies except in FIR No.10 dated 11.06.2025 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Economic Offences Wing, Vigilance Bureau, Ludhiana (Sections 465, 466, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC were added on 20.06.2025).

3. Mr. Deepender Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He, on instructions, submits that although a complaint has been received on 06.06.2025, however, no notice as of date, has been issued in this regard and the said complaint is still under the process of verification.

5. The present petition is **disposed of** with a direction to the State that in case the petitioners are sought to be arrested in the said complaint or any other complaint made by respondent No.2, prior to taking any action to the said complaint, a 07 days notice be sent to the petitioner .
