Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and also directing respondents No.4 and 5 not to interfere in the personal life and liberty of the petitioner.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent No.4 is son of the petitioner, who is persistently threatening the petitioner, who is none other than his mother. He submits that though on the earlier occasion, respondent-police was informed and respondent No.4 apologized to the petitioner, but thereafter, he is again harassing the petitioner. He submits that the petitioner has also filed a representation dated 23.06.2025 (Annexur P-2) to respondent No.2, however, no action has been taken thereon till date.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Ms. Sharmila Sharma, Addl. PP. Accepts notice on behalf of UT, Chandigarh. She has submitted that on receiving the phone call, the respondent-police approached the petitioner and her grievances were heard. Statement of the



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petitioner was also recorded, wherein, she deposed that she does not need protection any more. However, learned State counsel submits that if any such harassment or complaint is reported, further action would be taken in accordance with law.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to pursue her remedy in case any further cause of action accrues to her.
