1. This is a petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 25.03.2025 (Annexure P-1), passed by this Court in CWP-8443-2025.

Learned State counsel has filed compliance affidavit dated 04.08.2025 and appended therewith is a copy of order dated 04.08.2025 (Annexure R-1), purported to be an order passed in deference to the supra order dated 25.03.2025 (Annexure P-1).
