Prayer made in the present writ petition is for setting aside the charge sheet dated 05.01.2021 (Annexure P-1), enquiry report dated 05.06.2021 (Annexure P-2), punishment order dated 09.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Punishing Authority whereby the petitioner was dismissed from service and the order dated 28.12.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Appellate Authority dismissing the statutory appeal filed by the petitioner.

2 Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent/Bank points out that the impugned order imposing punishment of dismissal from service relates to two charge sheets and that only one charge sheet and the outcome thereof is the subject matter of challenge in the present writ petition and the second chargesheet or its final outcome is not under challenge.

3 Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition so as to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action but with better and complete particulars, if so advised.

4 Learned counsel appearing for the respondents has no objection to the same.

5 Disposed of as withdrawn with liberties as aforesaid while keeping all objections of the respondent open to be raised at an appropriate stage.
