Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS is for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 to expeditiously decide the pending representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that respondent No.4 has not only illegally destroyed and obstructed the path but he also openly threatened the petitioner with dire consequences as he has high level connections and influence with senior government officials and revenue authorities, which is creating a sense of fear and insecurity in the petitioner. Therefore, the petitioner moved representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No.3, but no action on the same has been taken till date.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would be satisfied if the representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-1), which had already been moved by the petitioner is looked into.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that she has no objection if the aforesaid representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-1) is looked into.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, to look into the aforesaid representation and to take appropriate action as per law, if any required, at the earliest.
