In compliance of order dated 11.07.2025, status report by way of an affidavit of Inderpal Chauhan, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Patran, District Patiala, has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, which is taken on record.

It has been alleged in the status report that during the course of investigation, accused Satpal Singh @ Pala Foji was arrested by the Investigating Agency on 14.06.2025 and on 16.06.2025, a revolver .32 bore along with 3 cartridges and 3 empties were recovered from him by the Investigating Agency on the basis of disclosure statement suffered by him. It has been further submitted that sincere efforts are being made by the police to arrest Gurjeet Singh (respondent No.4) and Nirmal Singh @ Langra (respondent No.5). On various dates, raids had been conducted at their houses, but they were not found present. Raids were also conducted at their

relatives houses but they could not be found. In order to find the whereabouts of respondents No.4 and 5, CDRs and Mobile Tower location of their mobile numbers were obtained from the concerned Nodal Officer by the Investigating Agency, but their mobile numbers were switched off, due to which their location could not be tracked. Accused Gurpreet Singh (respondent No.4) and Nirmal Singh @ Langra (respondent No.5) moved a representation dated 13.06.2025 before Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala regarding their innocence in the present case and enquiry of the same is being conducted by Superintendent of Police (Detective), Patiala. It has been further submitted that all the possible measures are being adopted to arrest the accused i.e. respondents No.4 and 5 and to take the investigation of the present case to its logical conclusion at its earliest.

Keeping in view of the aforesaid status report, it is made out that the proper investigation is being conducted by the police in the present case and no further order is required to be passed. However, respondent No.2 is directed to ensure that life and liberty of the petitioner is not jeopardized at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and to take the necessary steps, if any, required in accordance with law.

The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
